

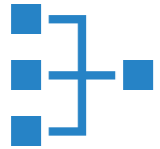

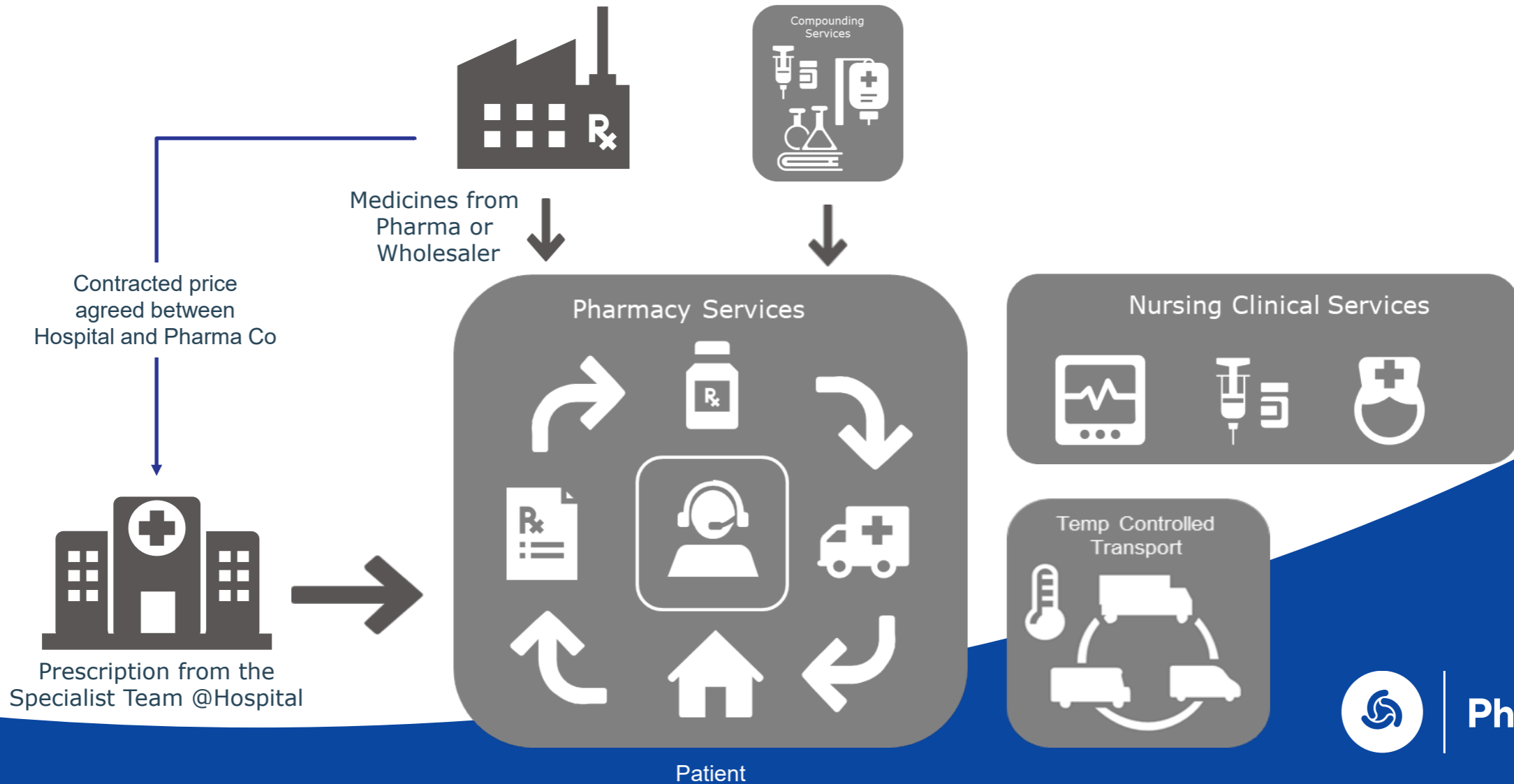

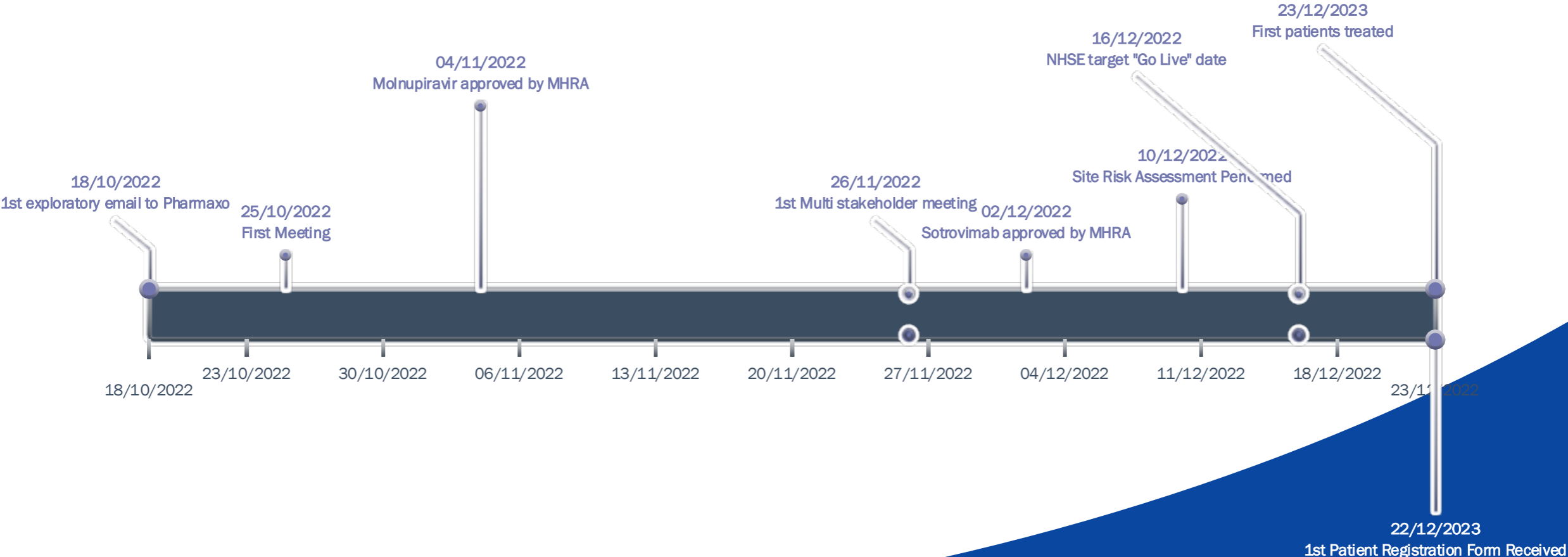
Emerging, Changing Situation

- Dec 2021 Directive from NHSE with short implementation time frame to set up CMDU for delivering treatment to vulnerable patients across ICS geography.
- Existing Acute and community NHS workforce already stretched dealing with the hospitalised COVID positive population and trying to enact recovery of elective activity.
- Requirement to triage and provide therapy both oral and parenteral for highly vulnerable patients in a safe setting minimising exposure to wider patient and general population across two ICS's (Frimley & Surrey Heartlands). Priorities for equity of access, timeliness of therapy delivery and maintaining safety of patients and staff.



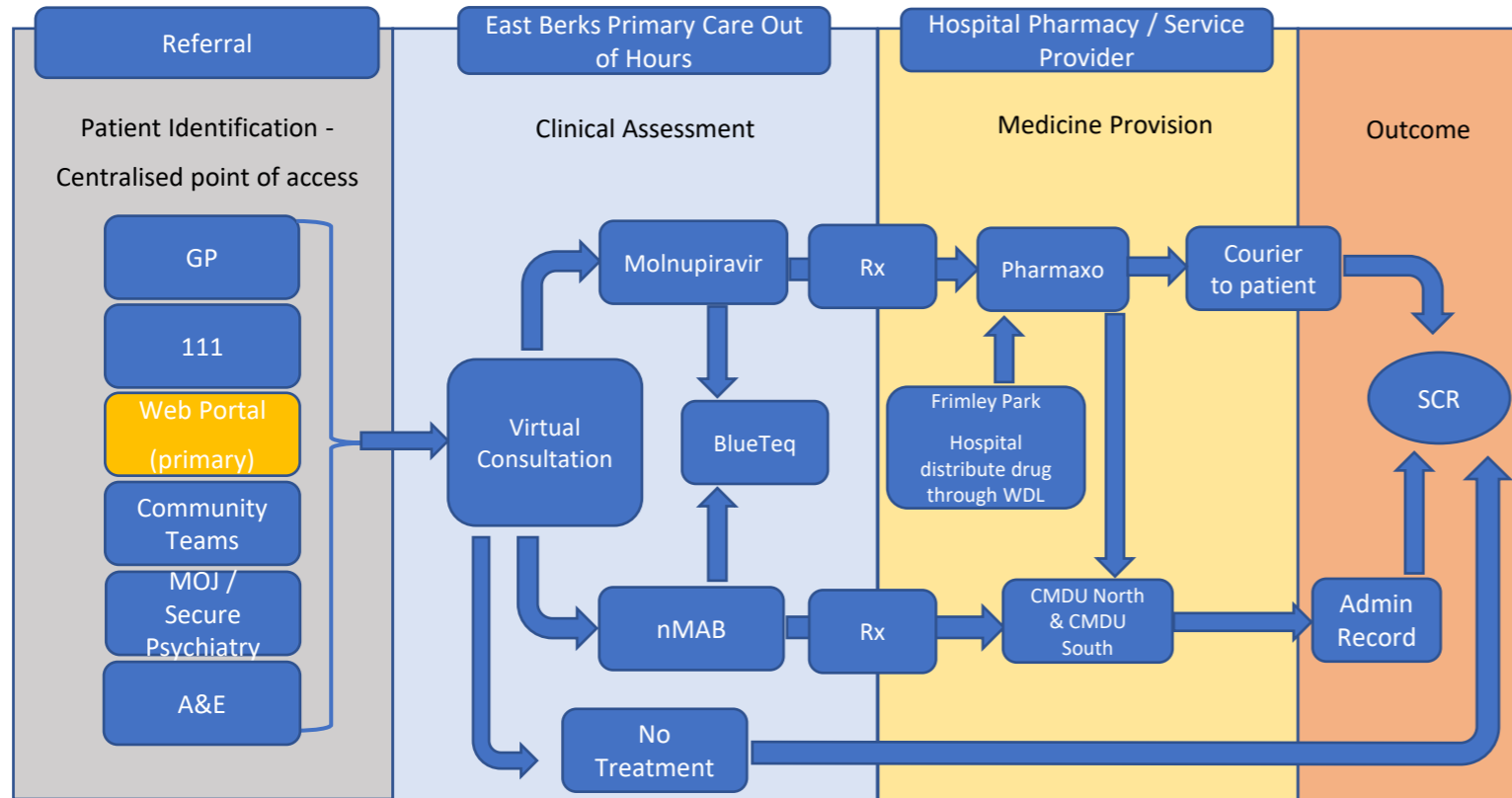

CMDU Process Map – Frimley ICS and Surrey Heartlands ICS



➤ **Established a multisite community based service model.**

- GP out of Hours team leading the remote triaging and prescribing for patients qualifying for therapy.
- Oral therapies delivered within 24hours to patients home by Pharmaxo.
- Parenteral therapy delivered at one of two community based sites away from acute healthcare activity utilising
- Pharmaxo homecare nursing teams to infuse patients.
